Parents meetings will take place on Tuesday 11th March and Wednesday 12th March. Class teachers have allocated time slots to parents. Please do attend these important meetings.

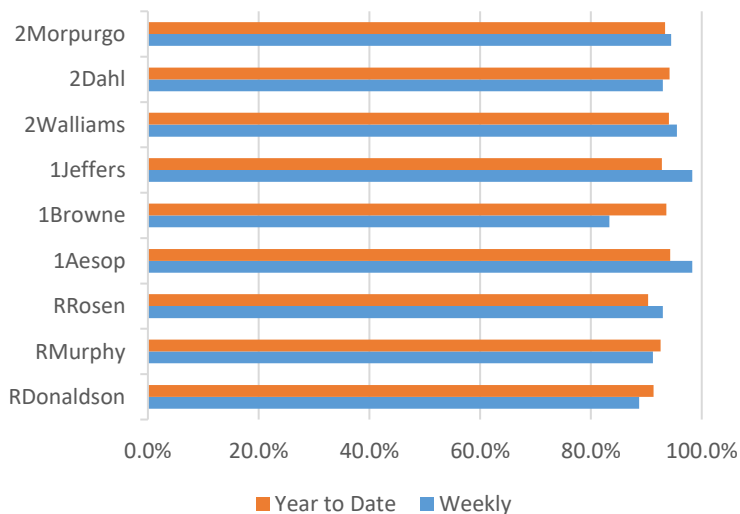
Nursery
