Hello families

A busy week here at Audley Infants. The children have settled well into school routine. I am delighted with how they have adapted to new routines and learning. **2Walliams: Aleena** - for fantastic artwork in the style of Van Gogh.

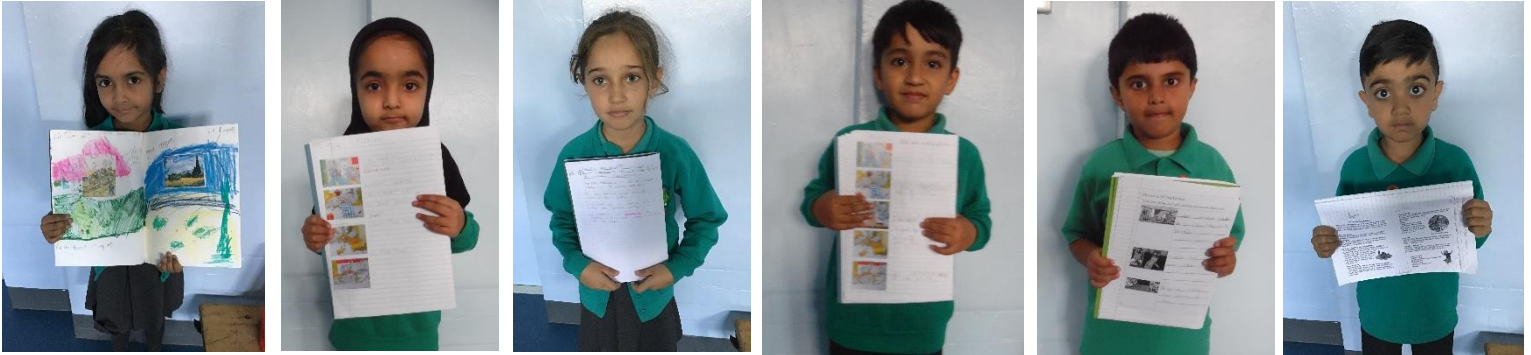
**2Dahl: Zayaan** - for his sticky knowledge with key vocabulary we have been learning.

**1Jeffers: Rayeid** - great retelling of the 'Moses' story.

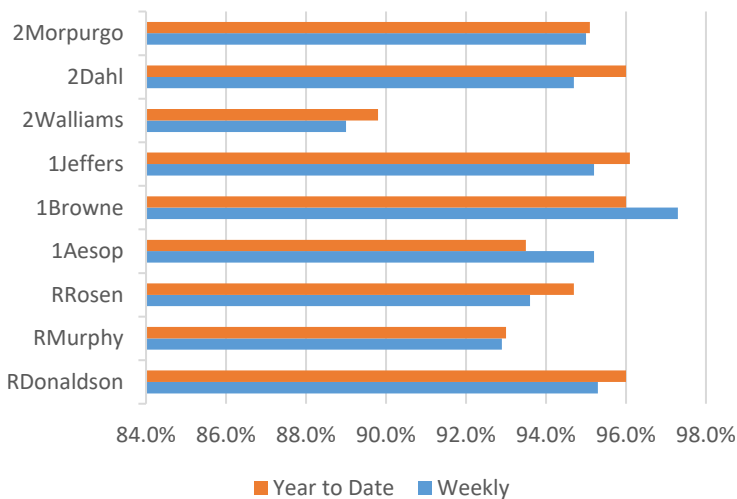
**1Browne: Harris** - beautiful writing using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.
