IMPORTANT INFORMATION—SAFETY AT HOME TIME

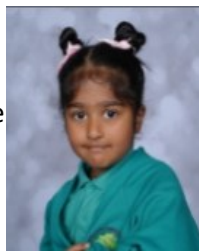

Coach Hayden did some special glow in the dark PE sessions with classes this week. Everyone really enjoyed the sessions and had lots of fun in PE.



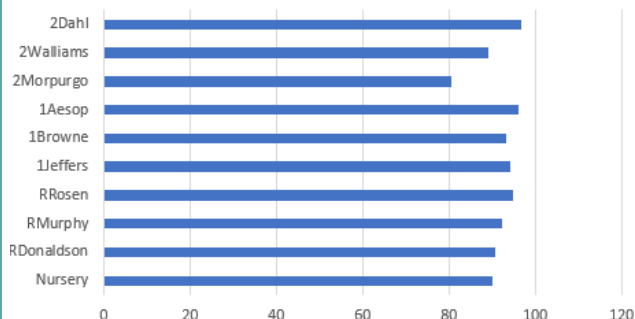

We aim for our children to have at least **96%** attendance in a year. This will ensure that they have the best opportunity to learn. We know that there are often genuine reasons for absence.

I have included some reminders of our requirements around attendance.

- Please call school before 9am each morning that your child is absent. If you do not, Miss Shah or a member of office staff will call you. You can leave a message or hold to speak to a member of office staff.
- Absence is not authorised if your child is off for a period of time without medical evidence. Miss Shah will advise you when you call.
- Routine appointments are not authorised during the school day. We will only authorize emergency appointments. We will ask to see an appointment card.

Lates

You must be on time every day for school - be ready on the yard for Y 1 & Y2 or, for Reception, at the blue gates at:

Reception – 08:50am.

Year 1/Year 2 – 08:45am.

Breakfast Club is open from 8am daily. All children receive breakfast. You do not need to book. Breakfast closes at 8:30am IT IS FREE.
